HOUSING ACCOMMODATIONS

All campers will be staying in air -conditioned hotel rooms, five in each room. Bedding will be provided. Towels are not provided so please bring your own. For the fifth person in your rooms, please bring an air mattress and bedding. Please note: at this time, we do not offer married housing or special accommodations for small children.

FOOD/ DIETARY ACCOMMODATIONS

All meals will be served in our dining hall. All three meals will be served at scheduled times. This year's dinners will be catered by Chick-Fil-A, Subway and Sonny's Barbecue. Concessions will be available during non-meal times and after evening sessions. At an additional expense, youth can purchase drinks, snacks, ice cream, candy, etc. during the day and hot foods like pizza and wings at night. YOUTH PASTORS: Please ensure that all allergy information is included on registration form so our culinary staff can make accommodations.

MEDICAL ACCOMMODATIONS

We have an on-site registered nurse for the entire duration of camp.

Camp Pack List:

- · Modest, casual clothing
 - T-shirts and/or tops
 - Jeans, sweats and/or shorts
 - Modest swimsuit
 - Girls: Modest one-piece or must wear long, dark-colored T-shirt over swimsuit
 - Guys: Must wear shirt at all times except at pool
 - Girls: Do NOT pack: mini skirts, crop tops, off the shoulder tops or short shorts
- NOTE: Camp leadership WILL ask you to change if clothing is inappropriate
- Towels & Washcloths
- Beach towel for the pool
- 3 plastic hangers to hang towels and wet clothing
- Water shoes

WHAT TO DO:

- Show up at least 5 minutes early to all sessions

- Bring Bible, pen and camp notebook to each session
- Wear Camp lanyard with schedule at all times (you will need it to enter the dining room and main sessions).
- Respect all leadership and church staff
- Staff's discretion will be used regarding inappropriate clothing (boys and girls)

WHAT NOT TO DO:

- Violate people or property (threats, verbal abuse, fighting)
- Show Public Displays of Affection (PDA)
- · Opposite gender wrestling
- Stealing
- Use profanity or racial slurs
- Disrespect authority
- Use tobacco, alcoholic substances, or non-prescription drugs
- Fight or bring weapons
- No Guys on the Girls Floor and No Girls on the Guys Floor!
- Have in possession or view pornography
- Leave campus without permission
- Use shaving cream, toothpaste or toilet paper other than intended use
- Wandering away from public areas
- · Leave room after curfew
- No guy/girl ministry time i.e. praying together alone
- Not abiding by these rules will result in disciplinary action that could include dismissal from camp at your expense.
